TREE TRIMMING

The Town of Birch Hills will be starting some tree trimming this spring/summer. Any trees or branches that encroach onto town easements or right-of-ways will be removed. This includes all streets, alleyways, sidewalks, pathways etc.

Please approach any neighbours to trim any trees that may overhang onto your personal property.

Elm Trees have a pruning ban from March 31 to August 31 of each year. According to legislation, if it is necessary to prune/remove an elm tree to ensure human safety or to avoid damage to other property it can be done by the municipality as long as proper authorities are notified and policy is followed.

Please take extra caution when the town crew is in your neighbourhood to ensure your safety and theirs.

The Weldon 4-H Beef Club is the local beef club consisting of 14 members from the Birch Hills, Kinistino and Weldon areas.


Our members begin to work with their beef projects starting in the fall. Through our monthly meetings, club activities and various 4-H clinics, the members learn a great deal through the 4-H season.
