First and foremost the Recreation Board would like to thank those past hockey referees, who have given their endless support, time and effort in helping with the hockey officiating in our community. It is volunteers like you that help to keep the game of hockey alive in our town. We hope that we can count on your assistance again this upcoming season.

Once again the Saskatchewan Hockey Association is partnering with Birch Hills to hold a referee clinic on November 20, 2011. This year they are introducing a two hour an on-ice session. The clinics have been shortened to half day classes giving the opportunity to run on-ice clinics immediately following the classroom portion.
