KNITTING GRANNIES

Five years have passed since a group of Birch Hills ladies gathered and formed the "Knitting Grannies" in 2012. Beginning in the Seniors' Hall they soon out grew the available storage space, and so arrangements were made with the museum that they could meet there on the second and fourth Tuesday of the month with space available to store their supplies. The group now has 7 regular members and 9 more that come when they can.

A very ambitious effort has seen comfort shawls delivered to Care Homes including Birch Hills, Duck Lake, Rosthern, Shellbrook, Weldon, Melfort, St. Brieux, Tisdale, Smeaton and Nipawin. Shirley Lyons and Faye Erikson seek out the needs which also include items for local individuals.

Mitts and toques are also very popular items. They have been delivered to elementary schools in Birch Hills, Muskoday and Prince Albert, to the Birch Hills Day Care, the Birch Hills Ministerial Assoc. for their Christmas hampers, the Prince Albert Women's Shelter, the Prince Albert Children's Haven and the Prince Albert Addiction Centre.

As the ladies settle into their fall schedule they will deliver the items they have ready to go to the P.A. Group Home, chemo hats to the Vic Hospital, as well as stuffed knitted toys and small "Lovey" blankets to the Vic Hospital's Ronald McDonald Family Room.

Socializing and coffee breaks are a part of this group as they fill a real need in the community. They are looking for people who knit or crochet (or would like to learn) and are of like mind to join their group --- could it be you??
