

The Birch Hills Historical Society's Thrift store will remain closed until further notice, as will the Museum.

That decision was confirmed at a meeting of the society's board of directors September 9. The board will continue to review the situation monthly.

In addition, the board has decided that no donations of items for the Thrift Store will be accepted while the store remains closed.

We recognize and appreciate the support the store has had from both donors and buyers over many years of operation, and want to resume when it is safe and reasonable to do so.

In the interim, we suggest that donors with items for the store consider other outlets, such as the Salvation Army operations in Melfort and Prince Albert, or Value Village.
