BYLAW NO. 7/91

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS RESPECTING SMOKING AT THE BIRCH HILLS CIVIC CENTRE.

WHEREAS it has been determined that second-hand tobacco smoke and side-stream smoke from cigarettes, cigars and pipes is a health hazard and discomfort for inhabitants of the Town of Birch Hills.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Birch Hills to regulate smoking in the Civic Centre as is more particularly set out in this bylaw:

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

No Smoking allowed in the Town Office, Rural Municipality Office, Library, Council Chambers, Kitchen, Hallways or Washrooms of the Birch Hills Civic Centre.


READ A FIRST TIME THIS 26th DAY OF NOVEMBER, A.D. 1991
