BYLAW 1/95

A BYLAW TO PERMIT AND REGULATE THE OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES

The Council of the Town of Birch Hills, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

It shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile within the Town of Birch Hills under the provisions of the Vehicles Act and the Snowmobile Act as follows-

- (1) Except on Bellamy Avenue and McCallum Avenue.
- (2) Notwithstanding (1), it shall be lawful to operate a snowmobile on the portions of the above avenues only for the purpose of crossing the said avenues.
- (3) No person shall drive or operate a snowmobile on private property except with the consent of the owner or occupant of the said property OR on school grounds, nursing home grounds, park areas, playgrounds, golf course or the Birch Hills airport except those engaged in regular maintenance of the grounds or buildings thereon.
- (4) A person who is guilty of a violation of any provision of this Bylaw, for which no other penalty is imposed, is liable on summary conviction for the first offence to a fine of not more than \$100.00 and for a subsequent offence to a fine not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term of not less than seven days nor more than sixty days.
- (5) Previous Bylaw #185 is hereby repealed.
- (6) This bylaw shall come into force on the date of approval by the Highway Traffic Board.
