A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS RESPECTING SMOKING IN THE BIRCH HILLS CURLING RINK

WHEREAS it has been determined that second-hand tobacco smoke and side-stream smoke from cigarettes, cigars and pipes is a health hazard and discomfort for inhabitants of the Town of Birch Hills.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable for the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of Birch Hills to regulate smoking in the Curling Rink as is more particularly set out in this bylaw:

NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

No Smoking allowed anywhere in the Birch Hills Curling Rink.
