BYLAW 6/01

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT RESPECTING FIRE PROTECTION FOR THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF INVERGORDON, NO. 430.

The Council of the Town of Birch Hills, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Town of Birch Hills is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw and identified as Exhibit "A", with the following Corporation.

Rural Municipality of Invergordon, No. 430

Rural Municipality of Birch Hills, No. 460

for the purpose stated within the agreement.

2. The Mayor and the Administrator of the Town of Birch Hills are hereby authorized to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as EXHIBIT "A".

EXHIBIT "A"

FIRE PROTECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS
AND THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BIRCH HILLS NO. 460
AND THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF INVERGORDON NO.430

This agreement made in triplicate this 26th day
of July, A.D. 2001.

BETWEEN

THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS, a body corporate with head
office at the Town of Birch Hills in the Province of
Saskatchewan hereinafter called the Party of the First Part.

AND

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF BIRCH HILLS NO. 460, a body
corporate with head office at the Town of Birch Hills in
the Province of Saskatchewan and hereinafter called the
Party of the Second Part.

AND

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF INVERGORDON NO. 430, a body
corporate with the head office at the ~~village of St. Louis~~
in the Province of Saskatchewan and hereinafter called the
Party of the Third Part.

Hamlet of Crystal Springs

WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS the Town of Birch Hills and the Rural Municipality
of Birch Hills No. 460 have entered into an agreement to
provide adequate fire protection within the boundaries of their
municipal corporations; and whereas the Rural Municipality of
Invergordon No. 430 has made a request to the Town of Birch Hills
and the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills No. 460 to provide
adequate fire protection for Division Six (6).

THEREFORE THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The fire trucks and equipment owned by the Town of Birch
Hills and the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills No. 460
may be called upon to answer fire calls within the
boundaries of Division 6 of the Rural Municipality of
Invergordon No. 430.

2. There shall be a charge for trucks and men for time spent on calls and charged to the land owner in the Rural Municipality of Invergordon No. 430.
3. The Rural Municipality of Invergordon No. 430 shall pay an annual charge of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to the Town of Birch Hills and the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills No. 460 on or before the first day of January of each year this agreement is in force.
4. This agreement shall be deemed to be continuous for three years but may be terminated by either party by giving thirty days advance written notice of the intention before January 1st of any year.
5. This agreement shall come into force and take effect from and after the day of final signing of this agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF the Councils of the Town of Birch Hills and the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills No. 460 and the Rural Municipality of Invergordon No. 430 have affixed their respective seal and official signatures this 26th day of July, A.D. 2001.


