- on the notice of assessment required by Sections 215 and 219 of the Act
- 4 the Board A fee of \$50.00 per appeal is hereby established for the purpose of filing an appeal to
- S The applicable fee shall be payable to the Municipality and shall be paid at the time of filing the appeal.
- 6 bylaw, the appeal is deemed to be dismissed. Where an appellant fails to pay the applicable fee pursuant to Sections 4 and 5 of the
- 7 Municipality shall refund any fee that was submitted by the appellant if
- <u>a</u>) or the Assessment Appeal Committee of the Saskatchewan Municipal Board; the appeal is successful either in whole or in part by decision of either the Board
- b) the appeal is not filed by the Secretary of the Board,
- the appeal is withdrawn in accordance with Section 227 of the Act, or
- an agreement is entered into pursuant to Section 228 of the Act.
