A BYLAW TO UNDERTAKE CURB, ROAD CONSTRUCTION AND PAVING AS A LOCAL IMPROVEMENT

1. The undertaking of curb, road construction and pavement as a local improvement is hereby authorized on:

The mayor and administrator are authorized to sign and seal any promissory note, notes or renewals to effect such loans or advances.
- 5. The lifetime of the work described above, as estimated by the engineer is seven (7) years.
