# Bylaw 08/18

# A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS TO ESTABLISH A BIRCH HILLS SKATING RINK COMMITTEE

The Council of the Town of Birch Hills in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

#### **SHORT TITLE**

1. This bylaw may be known as "Skating Rink Bylaw".

#### **DEFINITIONS**

- 2. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
  - a. Arena means the Birch Hills Skating Rink.
  - b. **BH&DRB** means the Birch Hills and District Recreation Board.
  - c. **Committee** means the management committee appointed pursuant to this bylaw.
  - d. Council means the Council of the Town of Birch Hills.
  - e. Municipality or Town means the Town of Birch Hills.
  - f. Your Facility— means the Skating Rink facility located on Birch Hills property including buildings and surfaces intended for activities such as hockey, figure skating & public skating.

## **COMPOSITION OF BOARD**

- 3. The committee shall consist of 9 members, to be appointed by resolution of Council as follows:
  - a. one member of Council;
  - b. six (6) members (one from each of the user groups.)
  - c. two (2) members at large from the community
- 4. At the first appointment of the committee members, the terms of office for elected members shall be as follows;
  - a. four (4) members for a one year term
  - b. five (5) members for a two year term
- 5. Subject to Section 4b;
  - a. each term of office shall be two years, and
  - b. three consecutive terms of office may be served, however, subsequent to serving three terms, there shall be an obligatory one year of absence from the committee.

- 6. The committee shall appoint one member as:
  - a. Chairperson;
  - b. Vice-chairperson; and
  - c. Secretary-treasurer
- 7. The seat of a member of the committee who absents himself/herself from three consecutive meetings, without authorization by resolution of the committee, shall be declared vacant.
- 8. The seat of a member of the committee shall become vacant upon the receipt of a written notice of resignation by the Secretary-treasurer of the committee.
- 9. The Secretary-treasurer of the committee shall bring to the attention of Council at its next meeting any vacancies as they arise.
- 10. The committee shall make recommendations to Council to fill vacancies as they arise.
- 11. Council shall, by resolution, at the first meeting following receipt of the notice of a vacancy, fill the vacancy.
- 12. Five (5) members shall constitute a quorum.

## **MEETINGS**

- 13. The committee shall meet at least once a month from September to May, at a time and place, as set by resolution of the committee at the first meeting of the committee each year.
- 14. The Secretary-treasurer of the committee shall, at the request of the chairperson or one third of the members call a special meeting at a date specified in the request.
- 15. All meetings of the committee shall be open to the public.
- 16. The Recreation Director must be advised of all meetings of the committee.
- 17. All members of the committee present shall vote on each question.
- 18. The chairperson shall preside at all meetings.
- 19. If the chairperson should be unable to attend the meeting, the vice-chairperson shall preside.

- 20. All actions of the committee shall be entered in a minute book, to be kept for that purpose by the Secretary-treasurer and signed by the presiding officer and the Secretary-treasurer.
- 21. The chairperson shall, monthly from September to May, report in writing to BHRB, and shall provide a report in person, on the activities of the committee, at a meeting of the BHRB following the end of the operating season.
- 22. An annual meeting of the residents of the municipality and other interested persons, shall be held in May of each year.
- 23. At the annual meeting the Secretary-treasurer of the committee shall present, for approval, the audited financial statement of the previous year, as well an interim financial report of the current year's operation.

#### **POWERS AND DUTIES**

- 24. The committee shall establish annual goals and objectives.
- 25. The committee shall, at its first meeting each year, elect one member to represent it on the BHRB.
- 26. The financial year of the committee shall be the calendar year.
- 27. The committee shall submit a copy of its assessment of the facility needs and its yearly goals and objectives to BH&DRB, before March 1 of each year.
- 28. The committee, with the Recreation Director, shall before March 1 of each year, prepare a budget, being an estimate of its proposed revenues and expenditures for the current calendar year operations.
- 29. The committee shall manage and operate the following facility:
  - a. Birch Hills Skating Rink
- 30. The committee shall establish and follow a schedule of regular maintenance for preserving the safety and usability of the Skating Rink surfaces and area.
- 31. Once in the spring and once in the fall, the committee shall make a thorough inspection of the Skating Rink surface and surrounding area and make a plan to repair any safety hazards.
- 32. The committee shall make visual inspections of the facility to ensure the safety of the facility.

- 33. The committee shall include a report of all maintenance and inspections in its monthly report to BH&DRB.
- 34. The committee may advise BH&DRB in all matters placed before it dealing with the Birch Hills Skating Rink.
- 35. All volunteers working for the committee shall be considered agents of the municipality.
- 36. The Secretary-treasurer of the committee shall, at year end, ready the financial records for presentation to BH&DRB.
- 37. The Secretary-treasurer of the committee shall deposit all funds to the credit of the BH&DRB in the Affinity Credit Union. All deposit slips must be given to the Recreation Director and all invoices must be submitted to BH&DRB for payment.
- 38. All operating funds of the committee shall remain in a separate ledger account in the BH&DRB.
- 39. The committee must receive approval from BH&DRB for any improvements or extension.
- 40. All purchases above \$5,000.00 not provided for in the budget must be approved by BH&DRB
- 41. The committee shall assess the recreation needs of the residents of the municipality:
  - a. for the current year
  - for a five year projection and provide BH&DRB and with a copy of these assessments annually.
- 42. The committee shall encourage and co-operate with organizations in the promotion of programs.

## **REPEAL**

43. Bylaw #02/89 is hereby repealed.

# **COMING INTO FORCE**

44. This bylaw shall come into force on final passing thereof.
