Bylaw 04/2021

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF BIRCH HILLS TO ESTABLISH A BIRCH HILLS SPORTS GROUNDS COMMITTEE

The Council of the Town of Birch Hills in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This bylaw may be known as "Sports Grounds Bylaw".

DEFINITIONS

- 2. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a. **BH&DRB** means the Birch Hills and District Recreation Board.
 - b. **Committee** means the management committee appointed pursuant to this bylaw.
 - c. Council means the Council of the Town of Birch Hills.
 - d. **Municipality or Town** means the Town of Birch Hills.
 - e. Sports Grounds means the Birch Hills Sports Grounds.
 - f. Your Facility—means the Sports Grounds facility located on Birch Hills property including buildings and surfaces intended for activities such as baseball, softball, playground and campground.

COMPOSITION OF BOARD

- 3. The committee shall consist of 7 members, to be appointed by resolution of Council as follows:
 - a. One (1) member of Council;
 - b. Four (4) members of the user group from the Town of Birch Hills and district that are elected at the annual meeting by those in attendance.
 - c. Two (2) members at large.
- 4. Four (4) members must be present to constitute a quorum.

MEETINGS

- 5. The committee shall meet at least twice annually at a time and place, as set by resolution of the committee at the first meeting of the committee each year.
- 6. The Secretary-treasurer of the committee shall, at the request of the chairperson or one third of the members call a special meeting at a date specified in the request.

- 7. All meetings of the committee shall be open to the public.
- 8. The Recreation Director must be invited to all meetings of the committee.
- 9. All members of the committee present shall vote on each question.
- 10. The chairperson shall preside at all meetings.
- 11. If the chairperson should be unable to attend the meeting, the vice-chairperson shall preside.
- 12. All actions of the committee shall be entered in a minute book, to be kept for that purpose by the Secretary-treasurer and signed by the presiding officer and the Secretary-treasurer.
- 13. The committee shall appoint a member of the committee and an alternate to be their representative on the BH&DRB and shall provide a report in person, on the activities of the committee, at all meetings of the BHRB.
- 14. An annual meeting of the residents of the municipality and other interested persons, shall be held in April of each year.
- 15. At the annual meeting of the BH&DRB the Secretary-treasurer of the committee shall present, for approval, the audited financial statement of the previous year, as well an interim financial report of the current year's operation.

POWERS AND DUTIES

- 16. The committee shall establish annual goals and objectives.
- 17. The financial year of the committee shall be the calendar year.
- 18. The committee shall submit a copy of its assessment of the facility needs and its yearly goals and objectives to BH&DRB, before April 1 of each year.
- 19. The committee, with the Recreation Director, shall before April 1 of each year, prepare a budget, being an estimate of its proposed revenues and expenditures for the current calendar year operations.
- 20. The committee shall manage and operate the following facility:
 - a. Birch Hills Sports Grounds.
 - b. Camp Grounds

- 21. The committee shall establish and follow a schedule of regular maintenance for preserving the safety and usability of the Sports Grounds surfaces and area.
- 22. Once in the spring and once in the fall, the committee shall make a thorough inspection of the Sports Grounds and surrounding area and make a plan to repair any safety hazards.
- 23. The committee shall make visual inspections of the facility to ensure the safety of the facility.
- 24. The committee shall include a report of all maintenance and inspections in its regular report to BH&DRB.
- 25. The committee may advise BH&DRB in all matters placed before it dealing with Birch Hills Sports Grounds.
- 26. All volunteers working for the committee shall be considered agents of the municipality.
- 27. The Recreation Director with the assistance of the Secretary-treasurer of the committee shall, at year end, ready the financial records for presentation to the BH&DRB to be audited by the municipal auditor.
- 28. The Secretary-treasurer of the committee shall deposit all funds to the credit of the BH&DRB in the Affinity Credit Union. Those funds shall be withdrawn only by cheque signed by the Recreation Director and one other of the BH&DRB appointed signatories. All deposit slips must be given to the Recreation Director and all invoices must be submitted to BH&DRB for payment.
- 29. The committee may advise or make recommendations to BH&DRB with respect to improvements or extension to Sports Grounds.
- 30. The committee must receive approval from BH&DRB for any improvements or extension.
- 31. All purchases above \$1,500.00 not provided for in the budget must be approved by BH&DRB.

32. The committee shall encourage and co-operate with organizations in the promotion of programs and will be consulted with on any matters affecting the sports grounds, campground and associated land base.

REPEAL

33. Bylaw No. 09/18 is hereby repealed.

COMING INTO FORCE

34. This bylaw shall come into force on final passing thereof.
