Bylaw 05/2021

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH BIRCH HILLS SKATEBOARD PARK COMMITTEE

The Council of the Town of Birch Hills in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

1. This bylaw may be known as "Skateboard Park Bylaw".

DEFINITIONS

- 2. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a. **BH&DRB** means the Birch Hills and District Recreation Board.
 - b. Church means the Birch Hills Community Church and Owner.
 - c. **Committee** means the management committee appointed pursuant to this bylaw.
 - d. Council means the Council of the Town of Birch Hills.
 - e. **Municipality or Town** means the Town of Birch Hills.
 - f. **Skateboard Park** means the multi-use facility located on Birch Hills Community Church property including surfaces intended for activities such as skateboarding and basketball.

COMPOSITION OF BOARD

- 3. The committee shall consist of five (5) members, to be appointed by resolution of council as follows:
 - a. one member of council;
 - b. one (1) representatives of the church;
 - c. one (1) member of the user group (one parent, one youth); and
 - d. two (2) representative from the Town of Birch Hills and district that are elected at the annual meeting by those in attendance.
- 4. At the first appointment of the committee members, the terms of office for elected members shall be as follows;
 - a. 1 member for a one year term
 - b. 1 member for a two year term

- 5. Subject to Section b,
 - a. each term of office shall be two years, and
 - b. three consecutive terms of office may be served, however, subsequent to serving three terms, there is an obligatory one year of absence from the committee.
- 6. The committee shall appoint one member as:
 - a. Chairperson;
 - b. Vice-chairperson; and
 - c. Secretary
- 7. The seat of a member of the committee who absents himself/herself from three consecutive meetings, without authorization by resolution of the committee, shall be declared vacant.
- 8. The seat of a member of the committee shall become vacant upon the receipt of a written notice of resignation by the secretary of the committee.
- 9. The secretary of the committee shall bring to the attention of the council at its next meeting any vacancies as they arise.
- 10. The committee shall make recommendations to council to fill vacancies as they arise.
- 11. The council shall, by resolution, at the first meeting following receipt of the notice of a vacancy, fill the vacancy.
- 12. Three (3) members shall constitute a quorum.

MEETINGS

- 13 The committee shall meet at least twice between March and November, at a time and place, as set by resolution of the committee at the first meeting of the committee each year.
- 14 The secretary of the committee shall, at the request of the chairperson or one third of the members call a special meeting at a date specified in the request.
- 15 All meetings of the committee shall be open to the public.
- 16 All members of the committee present shall vote on each question.
- 17 The chairperson shall preside at all meetings.

- 18 If the chairperson should be unable to attend the meeting, the vice-chairperson shall preside.
- 19 All actions of the committee shall be entered in a minute book, to be kept for that purpose by the secretary and signed by this presiding officer and the secretary.
- 20 The chairperson shall, every two months, being June and August, report in writing to the council and to the church office, and shall provide a report to the Recreation Director.
- 21 An annual meeting of the residents of the municipality and other interested persons, shall be held in April of each year.

POWERS AND DUTIES

- 22. The committee shall, at its first meeting each year, elect one member to represent it on the BH&DRB.
- 23. The committee shall establish and recommend to the Church, a schedule of regular maintenance for preserving the safety and usability of the Skateboard Park surfaces and area.
- 24. Once in the spring and once in the fall, the committee shall make a thorough inspection of the Skateboard park surface and surrounding area and recommend to the Church for the repair of any safety hazards as per Schedule A.
- 25. The committee shall make visual inspections of the facility to ensure the safety of the facility.
- 26. The committee shall include a report of all maintenance and inspections in its monthly report to council and to the church.
- 27. All volunteers working for the committee shall be considered agents of the municipality.
- 28. All operating funds of the committee shall remain separate from the BH&DRB and the town of Birch Hills.

REPEAL

29. Bylaw No. 08/13 is hereby repealed.

COMING INTO FORCE

30. This bylaw shall come into force on final passing thereof.
