BYLAW NO. 10-2022

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR ASSESSING AND LEVYING THE COST OF FIRE PREVENTION, SUPPRESSION AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE SERVICES

The Council of the Town of Birch Hills, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The cost of the fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services provided within the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills No. 460, Rural Municipality of Invergordon and Rural Municipality of St. Louis shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the services in accordance with "Schedule A" as attached hereto and forming a part of this bylaw. All RM and Hamlet ratepayers are encouraged to purchase fire insurances as this is not included in the rural municipal property taxes.
2. The cost of the fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services provided within the Town of Birch Hills will be charged directly to the Town as this service is provided within the urban municipal property taxes of the Town of Birch Hills in accordance with "Schedule A" as attached hereto and forming a part of this bylaw.
3. Bylaw No. 02-2021 is hereby repealed.

SERVICES PROVIDED AND APPLICABLE CHARGES

1. Pumper Unit\$800.00/hour includes 1 firefighter
2. Snuffer Unit\$800.00/hour includes 1 firefighter
3. Tanker Unit\$800.00/hour includes 1 firefighter
4. Command Unit.....\$800.00/hour includes 1 firefighter
5. Fireman\$ 50.00/firefighter/hour
6. Mileage\$ 5.00/km/unit
7. Jaws of Life\$800.00/hour
8. Restocking Supplies.....At cost
9. Minimum Charge.....\$1,000.00 (reference False Alarm Bylaw when applicable)
