May Heartbeat Sponsors

Beth (nee Warder) Rude has lived in, loved, and helped cultivate a vibrant community in Birch Hills truly for her whole life -- 90 years on May 24, 2021. And not only has she lived in Birch Hills 90 years, but she has lived on the same street that whole time. Born in the first Birch Hills Hospital at 309 McCallum Avenue, Beth is the daughter of Charlie and Ellen Warder, who both settled in Birch Hills after emigrating from England. As the youngest of six children, Beth grew up in the family home at 17 McCallum Avenue and completed high school in Birch Hills. The first High School, which opened in 1927, was situated across from the H.A. Wilson home at 61 McCallum Avenue. After high school Beth took Teacher's training in Saskatoon but continued to spend weekends in Birch Hills with her parents to help with her mother who had been diagnosed with Alzheimer's. In 1952 Beth married Alvin Rude of the Bonnie Hill district. The car they used for their honeymoon has remained part of the Birch Hills Threshing Day Parade through the years. The young couple moved into the Warder family home, continuing to care for Ellen while Beth began her teaching career. Both of Alvin and Beth's daughters, Kathryn and Kristina, were born at the new Birch Hills Hospital (now Birch Hills Memorial Museum), built on Wilson Street where McCallum Avenue begins. For much of her life, Beth combined raising a young family, supporting Alvin's farming, and teaching school. Conveniently the school buildings were across the street from the Warder home on McCallum Avenue. As Beth continued to teach and Alvin became a journeyman electrician, starting Rude Electric, Alvin and Beth were able to build their own home, right next door to the Warder house. In 1966 the Rude family moved into their new home at 11 McCallum Avenue, where Beth lived until 2011. Initially pink and white, the bungalow was green and white and boasted an enclosed carport by the time Beth sold it. Beth was an early adopter of the "high-rise" condo in Birch Hills, and currently resides in a lovely 4th floor suite located at 222 McCallum Avenue where she can look out from her balcony and see the former hospitals, the old Warder residence, the Birch Hills School, the family home of Alvin and Beth, and almost on the horizon, the Rude family farm just north of Bonnie Hills. McCallum Avenue in Birch Hills has been the centre of Beth's universe for almost a full century.

The Birch Hills School was Beth's second home for many years. In addition to teaching Home Economics and organizing student fashion shows, Beth taught English, and loved music - organizing and leading many groups of songsters. Outside of school, she sang and played the piano at the United Church and was part of Sweet Adelines. In the community Beth also volunteered at the Birchview Home and spearheaded the Memorial Wall at The Birch Hills Museum. She served with Saskatchewan History and Folklore Society for over a decade and remains keenly interested in Saskatchewan stories, developments, and politics. Recognition for her community contributions came when Beth received one of the Saskatchewan Centennial Medals which were awarded by the Lieutenant Governor of Saskatchewan in 2005 and early 2006.

Perhaps one of the most unexpected events of Beth's 90 years came as a result of Alvin's kidney failure. On May 8, 1997 Beth donated a kidney to Alvin, enabling him to live without twice a week trips for dialysis. This was a truly extraordinary gift.

Though Beth's life has been centred in Birch Hills, she has an extended circle of friends and family across the globe. Beth continues to reach out to those friends and relatives far and near, and is a source of knowledge to many. Her daughters and their families are very proud of her. She has five grandchildren and (to date) eight great-grandchildren. "Grandma Grandma" is simply the best. Happy 90th Birthday!


A bylaw pursuant to Section 214 of *The Municipalities Act* has been passed and the assessment notices have been sent as required.

VIRTUAL BOTTLE DRIVE

The 2021 Graduating class is holding a virtual bottle drive over the winter/spring to raise some funds for this momentous day and are looking for your support while still following COVID requirements. Individuals willing to donate recyclables can do so at any SARCAN location in the province by following these steps"

- 1. At home, separate your recycling put plastics, cartons and aluminum cans into bags, put glass beverage containers into boxes. Don't forget to include milk containers!
- 2. Visit a SARCAN Depot and look for Drop & Go
- 3. Follow instructions on the screen. Type **"BHGrad"** when prompted to enter the group phrase. It is simple!

The amount of your order will be processed and paid directly to the Birch Hills Graduating class

For Birch Hills residents wishing to donate but unable to attend a Drop and Go location, you can package your recyclables in boxes/bags as indicated, place them by the street in front of your property (weather/ conditions permitting), and text your address to 306-940-8922. Recyclables will then be picked up by this contactless method and delivered to a Drop and Go location on your behalf.

The group phrase works at all 72 depots across the province, so your friends and family across Saskatchewan can donate too! Please share this with your social media friends. Together we can make this day special regardless of how it may be affected by COVID.

Birch Hills Golf Course COVID-19 Policies (as of April 19, 2021)

- Social distancing (2m/6ft) is required AT ALL TIMES on the property.
- Provincial guidelines, legislation and fines apply while on the property, and must be strictly adhered to.
- Failure to comply with social distancing or any listed policies will result in removal from the course until policies are lifted.

BEFORE YOUR ROUND

- All tee times MUST be prebooked WALK-ONS will NOT be permitted. Book on-line at www.birchhillsgolfcourse.ca or call 306-749-2211 to book.
- Arrive on-time as we won't have the flexibility to fit you in if you are late.
- Tee times are now booked every 12 minutes; you may be paired up with other golfers.
- If you have any COVID-19 symptoms, or if you have been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19, STAY HOME.

FACILITY CHANGES

- 24 The clubhouse washrooms are open; the course washroom is closed.
- Hand sanitizer is available outside and inside the clubhouse and inside the cart sheds.
- All carts, keys, clubs and cooler bags are sanitized after each use.
- ©CREDIT or DEBIT are the preferred payment methods at the clubhouse. Payment over the phone (306-749-2211) is also permitted.

UPON ARRIVAL

- MASKS ARE MANDATORY in the clubhouse and on the deck (unless you are seated at a table).
- 200 Only 1 person is allowed in the clubhouse at a time; maintain social distancing.
- All golfers must use hand sanitizer before entering the clubhouse.
- Please wait to be assigned a cart.
- **Example** Carts may be shared.
- Ensure the group in front of you has left the first tee box before making your way there. All golfers must wait to tee off until their assigned time or until told to do so (NO EXCEPTIONS).

YOUR GOLFING EXPERIENCE

- A maximum of four golfers per group is permitted.
- Social distancing (2m/6ft) is required AT ALL TIMES, including with all golf course staff.
- Ball washers have been removed.
- Personal touching is not permitted at any time (includes handshakes, high fives, etc.).
- Flag poles are to remain in the hole AT ALL TIMES. Your ball is considered in the hole when it makes contact with the pin or when it drops in the hole. Use your club to retrieve your ball.
- 200 Only touch your own personal items balls, clubs and golf bags, etc.
- When letting other groups play through, please maintain social distancing
- The beverage cart will not operate most days. You may purchase your food and drinks prior to your round. Bringing your own liquor is illegal.

AFTER YOUR ROUND

- Maintain social distancing in the parking lot; the consumption of alcohol in the parking lot is illegal.
- Return your golf cart (power or pull) to the designated area.
- № Keys, cooler bags and rental carts are to be left in the rental cart.
- ₹ DISPOSE OF ALL OF YOUR GARBAGE IN A GARBAGE CAN OR TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU.

RCMP Jurisdictional Boundary Changes

The RCMP has recently re-evaluated the Prince Albert Detachment boundaries and reduced the service area, which effects Birch Hills.

The Change in boundaries was to improve RCMP response time, reduce investigator file loads and enhance community engagement. A review was completed by the RCMP North District Management Team. The change will take effect on May 1st at midnight.

The Town of Birch Hills, the majority of the RM of Invergordon, Village of Weldon and RM of Kinistino will now be policed by Melfort RCMP Detachment. The change will not affect the service delivery to our community, as rural crime will remain a priority. The policing for the RM of Birch Hills will now be shared by both Melfort and Prince Albert Detachments.
