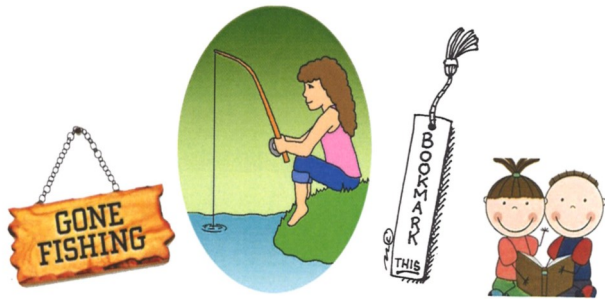

The Tin Bin Bakery & Deli opened December 3rd, 2020 in Birch Hills, SK in the middle of winter, during a pandemic. We are open Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays from 11:00am-7:00pm and Saturdays from 11:00-5:00pm.

We carry breads & buns (white, whole wheat, rye & sourdough; hamburger, hotdog & dinner buns, roasted garlic & cheese pull-aparts) baking (pretzels, doughnuts, cheese sticks, pies, muffins, cookies & tarts), deli meals (soups, pizzas, lasagne, frozen meals), meats (back bacon, pastrami, salami, beef, garlic sausage, sous vide chops, burgers) and other items.

All of our meats are processed in-house. Some of our meats are smoked in the “Tin Bin” smokehouse.

Your bread can be sliced in-house (thick or thin) or you can purchase a bread knife and slice your own at home.

We now have an ice cream machine to serve you soft-serve cones and ice cream cakes.

We are pleased to carry Living Sky Farms (livingskyfarms.ca @livingskyfarmssk products at the Tin Bin Bakery & Deli. Merle Lee Ann Pratt’s cookbook “A Baker’s Dozen” is also available to purchase.

Our offerings change weekly so drop in often to see what we have been cooking and baking.

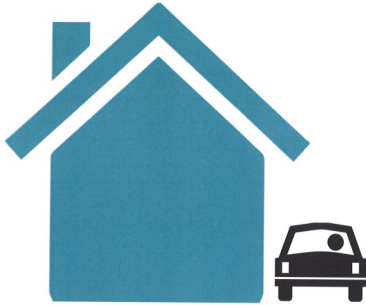

Greetings from the Birch Hills Multiuse Committee. We hope you are having a great spring! It has been a while since the last project update, and there has been great progress as we near the end of the construction process. As many of you have probably noticed, the exterior temporary construction wall has been removed, and you can see the front windows and entryway. The interior doors are installed, the painting is nearing completion, the suspended ceiling is done, and the flooring is currently being installed.

We continue to get financial support from the Community, and we cannot thank everyone enough, who has donated to the project over the past few years. We will be recognizing these donations in a manner befitting the level of support the community of Birch Hill, and surrounding area has shown to ensure this project is successful.

We would like to mention a recent donation from Jason Green & Amanda Gehard (Shirley Ulvild's grandson), who donated \$10,000. We also had a donation of a 50-inch television for the seniors, from Tracey Tomtene on behalf of her father Gordon Tomtene.
