

1) Food Preparation

Provide age appropriate nutritious meals and snacks according to Saskatchewan Childcare Regulations and Canada's Food Guide/Aboriginal Food Guide Prepare main meals and snacks.

Prepare nutritious snacks for the afternoon.

- Prepare creative meals and snacks that allow each child to experience new foods, flavors, and textures.
- Keep a running list of groceries, cleaning supplies and kitchen supplies needed.
- Prepare menu and shopping list accordingly.

2) Food Handling/Housekeeping

Handle and prepare all foods according to food safe techniques. Clean and sanitize after snacks and lunch. Load dishwasher and hand wash pots and pans. Disinfect cupboards, walls, appliances, etc. daily or as needed. Disinfect high traffic and commonly touched surfaces as needed Leave kitchen clean and tidy at the end of each shift. Perform other cleaning duties as required. Defrost freezer when needed. Assist staff with the center's laundry needs

3) Relief Childcare Worker

Relieve childcare staff for lunch and coffee breaks when required. Create and maintain warm and loving relationships with all children enrolled at the center

4) Working with Parents

Develop and maintain a positive relationship with parents. Assist in parent orientation.

5) Working with Other Staff

Provide support, suggestions and positive feedback to other staff members. Communicate ideas and concerns to other staff members constructively. Work with the Director to ensure the smooth running of the TLC Daycare Inc.

6) Personal Responsibilities

Contribute ideas. Be aware of stress levels and act appropriately. Attend and contribute to staff meetings. Be open to differences.
