### Birch Hills Blackhawks Lead TRHL Finals 2-0

The Blackhawks were victorious in their semi-final series against the Warman Wildcats, winning the best of 5 series 3 games to 1. Game 1 was a shutout 5-0 win for the Blackhawks. Warman tied up the series with a 6-4 win over Birch Hills in game 2. The Blackhawks won 4-3 in overtime in game 3 and in game 4, they won 5-2 to advance to the final series.

The Shellbrook Silvertips defeated the Rosthern Wheatkings 3 games to 1 to advance to the final series vs. Birch Hills. This is a rematch of the TRHL final series from 2 years ago when hockey was shut down across Canada due to Covid-19. The Blackhawks were leading the series 1-0 when this occurred.

Game 1 was a back-and-forth game, with Birch Hills coming out of the game with a 6-4 win. Game 2 in Shellbrook was another exciting game, with the Silvertips tying the score with less than 2 minutes left to send the game into overtime. The Blackhawks scored less than 1 minute into the 10minute sudden victory overtime period to win 4-3.

> Game 3 is at the Hesje Centre on Friday, March 18<sup>th</sup> at 8:30pm – it's sure to be another exciting game. A win that night will net the Blackhawks their 2<sup>nd</sup> Twin Rivers Hockey League Championship. Come out and cheer loud for the Birch Hills Blackhawks.
