The Sask Lotteries Community Grant Program money has arrived and the Rec Board will be accepting applications until October 15th. The purpose of the grant is to provide access to sport culture and recreation activities for all Saskatchewan people regardless of age, sex, ethnicity, economic status physical or mental ability;

The grant provides funds to community nonprofit volunteer organizations in sport, culture and recreation programs.

Expenditures must be <u>directly related</u> to the delivery of a sport, culture or recreation project.

Expenditures must occur within the grant period of April 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023.
