Bylaw Enforcement

We would like to again remind the community that Bylaw Enforcement will be strictly adhering to all Bylaws, regulations and policies alongside the office to ensure that Bylaw's are not being contravened and that properties are being maintained. In the near future you can expect to see an updated Waste and Recycle Bylaw, updated Nuisance Abatement Bylaw and others. There will be a strong Bylaw presence within the Town this season. Warning notices will only be issued once, thereafter charges and penalties being levied against the property. Please also note that Order to Remedies will be followed up with immediately and action will be taken to mediate unattended properties. If the issue is not remedied after a warning notice goes out, we will send out Town staff to clean up unkept property and will bill the property owner. We want to have a healthy and safe community and we can only have that if everybody does their part.



Items to be mindful of this season:

- Junked vehicles
- Dilapidated buildings
- Damaged, unoccupied buildings
- Open excavations on property
- Land that is overgrown with grass and weeds
- Dead or hazardous trees
- Sharp or dangerous objects in yard
- Building materials, scrapped lumber, scrap metal
- Rodent infestations



If your property has any of the above items, PLEASE HAVE THE ISSUE REMEDIED AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO AVOID BYLAW NOTICES AND FINES.

*Parked vehicles during snow removal and street sweeping: Please keep in mind that the Town hires for services such as street sweeping, and if your vehicle is not removed, it is a waste of taxpayer's money as well as creates access issues for equipment. Please remove your vehicle when advised to on our social media pages, website, newsletter(s), Heartbeat, bulletin boards and other forms of media. We publish the dates and times in advance to allow for ample time to make other parking arrangements.
