

## Main duties & responsibilities will include (but are not limited to):

The Third Party Administrator will report directly to the Administrators for the Rural Municipality of Birch Hills No. 460 and the Town of Birch Hills jointly:

- Provide information for the preparation of the annual budget;
- Document emergency call-outs;
- Process accounts payable;
- Process accounts receivable, which includes invoicing and receipt of payments;
- Prepare bank reconciliation;
- Process payroll, including T4's; and
- Prepare monthly and annual financial statements of revenue and expenditures, including capital expenditures.

#### Qualifications

- Accounting experience is essential;
