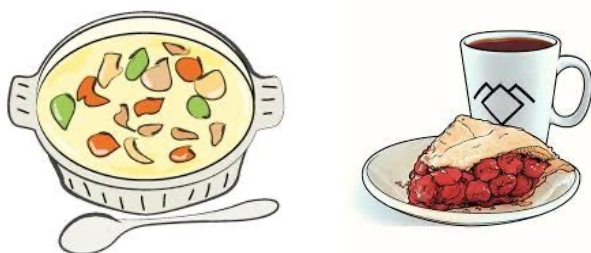

The Birch Hills Golf Course Annual General Meeting was held on Tuesday, April 4th at the Duane Lowe Community Centre. We say farewell and thank you to 2 board members – Brett Honish, who has served as our chairperson for many years, and Jordan Carrier. We welcome to the board Darryl Braaten and Jeff Whitfield.

Dean Bear assumes chairperson duties, while Bailey Braaten is vice-chairperson, Darryl Braaten is the secretary, Rochelle Fjeld is the Recreation Board Representative, Zac Pitzel will continue as Treasurer and Lyle Evans remains the Town's Representative. Members-at-large are Kim Bear and Jeff Whitfield. Jamie Tilford and Adam Morrison round out the board as the Clubhouse and Course representatives.

Rates will remain similar to last year. However, changes to the PST structure on October 1, 2022 will have an impact on some prices. For instance, a \$600 adult membership will now cost \$635. The only increase in rates was to golf cart rentals which will go a bit up due to rising gas prices. A list of the 2023 rates will be posted in the next Heartbeat and updated on our website (www.birchhillsgolfcourse.ca) at the same time.

Our 2023 opening day is yet to be determined. We are grateful for the moisture we have received this winter and anticipate that the course will be green and lush.

Hopefully more people from in and around Birch Hills will take up the game of golf and make this another great golf season. Lessons are available for anyone who would like to learn how to golf or to improve their game. We also have rental clubs available should you need them.

Half-price adult memberships are available for a limited time (date TBD) IF you haven't had a membership in the previous 5 years. These memberships don't include the Golf Canada membership (you may purchase separately) and must be paid in full at time of purchase.

Masks are optional for golfers in the clubhouse and on the deck. We will provide hand sanitizer and will continue to perform regular cleaning in and around the clubhouse. We hope that you can get out and enjoy a round of golf on our beautiful course. Or at least come out and enjoy the view from the deck...the sunsets are spectacular.

Once we open, we will operate from 7:00am until sunset, weather permitting. Ladies Night (Monday), Ladies Day (Tuesday) and Men's Night (Thursday) will be starting shortly after we open.

The proposed bylaw is to amend the mapping in Section 11 by rezoning the lands from FUD – Future Urban Development District to M1 – Light Industrial District.


The affected land is legally described as Par G, plan 101832937 shown within the bold line on the map labeled Schedule “A” attached to and forming part of this notice.
