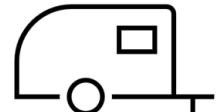
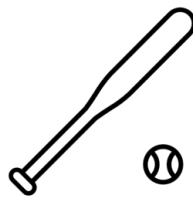
## BIRCH HILLS GOLF COURSE

**Opening Day 2023 was Monday May 1<sup>st</sup>.** Our greens are in fantastic condition.

We hope that more people from in and around Birch Hills will take up the game of golf and make this another great golf season. **Lessons are available** for anyone who would like to learn how to golf or to improve their game. We also have rental clubs available should you need them. It has been very encouraging to see all of the youth at the course and to have so many people use the driving range.

**Half-price adult memberships** are available until June 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023 IF you haven't had a membership in the previous 5 years. These memberships don't include the Golf Canada membership (you may purchase separately) and must be paid in full at time of purchase. Loyalty card stamps may not be used towards this membership.

We hope that you can get out and enjoy a round of golf on our beautiful course. Or at least come out and enjoy the view from the deck...the sunsets are spectacular. We are licensed and we have a limited menu for you to enjoy (homemade buns...mmmm)!

We are open from **7:00am until sunset, weather permitting**. Book on-line at [www.birchhillsgolfcourse.ca](http://www.birchhillsgolfcourse.ca) or call 306-749-2211 to reserve your tee time.

**Ladies Night** (Monday tee times starting at 6:00pm; not held on statutory holidays), **Ladies Day** (Tuesday tee times starting at 9:24am) and **Men's Night** (Thursdays with shotgun tee off at 6:00pm) have started or will begin May 15<sup>th</sup> week. **Junior Nights** will be held after ball season and we are entertaining the idea of a **Couples Night** if people are interested. We are looking for someone to organize Ladies Night and Ladies Day – please call the clubhouse 306-749-2211 if you are interested.

For this year's **Club Championship**, if you want to be entered to win the Men's "Net Trophy" (low handicap), you will be required to have an up-to-date handicap. This would require at least 10 rounds in the past calendar year in the calculation. If you have the regular priced \$635 membership, the Golf Canada membership is included. They have a handicap calculator and a dedicated app. This is the preferred method as it is easy to check. For the ½ price memberships, you can pay for a Golf Canada membership (also includes insurance), or use another app as long as you can show your rounds when requested.

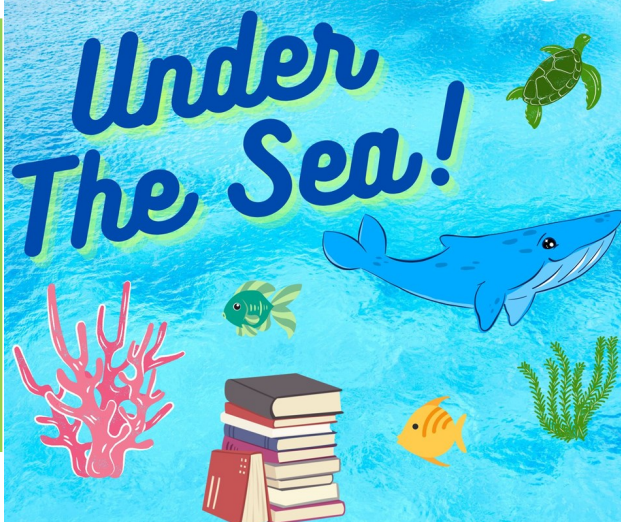
