BYLAW NO. 05-2023

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the Town of Birch Hills in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a. "Council" means the Council of the Town of Birch Hills; and
 - b. "Municipality" means Town of Birch Hills.
- 2. Council hereby appoints Darren Madraga as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
- 3. The appointment shall commence on June 1, 2023, and shall continue until Council can acquire a Community Safety Officer.
- 4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving thirty (30) days' written notice.
- 5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
 - a. To enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality
 - b. To represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw; and
 - c. Other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate.
- 6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
