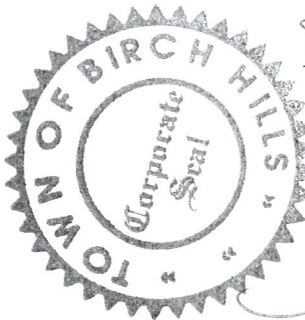
BYLAW NO. 05-2023

A BYLAW TO APPOINT A BYLAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

The Council of the Town of Birch Hills in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the expression:
 - a. "Council" means the Council of the Town of Birch Hills; and
 - b. "Municipality" means Town of Birch Hills.
2. Council hereby appoints Darren Madraga as the Bylaw Enforcement Officer for the Municipality.
3. The appointment shall commence on June 1, 2023, and shall continue until Council can acquire a Community Safety Officer.
4. The appointment may be terminated by Council or by the Bylaw Enforcement Officer giving thirty (30) days' written notice.
5. The duties of a Bylaw Enforcement Officer shall be:
 - a. To enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the council of the Municipality
 - b. To represent the Municipality before a justice of the peace or provincial court judge in the prosecution of anyone who is charged with contravention of a bylaw; and
 - c. Other duties as may be assigned by council or its delegate.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
